Located on the lagoon of the same name, Venice is the main city of Veneto and north-eastern Italy.</p> <p>It is the most visited city in Italy, ahead of Rome (18 million) and Florence (13 million). The affluence is fairly constant, with spikes during the Carnival, and between May and October.</p> <p>Venice was the gateway to the east, founded by refugees fleeing the barbarians, it became a Byzantine province which gained its independence in the 10th century. In the Middle Ages, it conquered a vast empire in the Mediterranean which assured for centuries wealth and power.</p> <p>The whole city and the Lagoon were declared in 1979 to the patrimony of the humanity of Unesco.</p>
