Description	Turin is best known for being an important industrial centre, famous for its Fiat factories; it is the capital of the automobile.
	But it is also a charming town with lovely architecture and many museums. Its architecture is characterized by a Piedmontese baroque (not painted). The city has nearly 24 kilometers of streets in arcades desired by King Victor Emmanuel II who wanted to ride horses without getting wet on rainy days.
	Before being under Roman rule in the third century before J.C. it was occupied by a Celtic people, the Taurini. Is in the first century before J.C. that the first emperor of Rome founded Augusta Taurinorum. In 1412 Piedmont was annexed by Savoy and Turin became the capital under the decision of Emmanuel Philibert Duke of Savoy in 1563 at the expense of Chambery. In the nineteenth century, the process of unification of Italy start in Turin under the leadership of King Victor Emmanuel of Savoy dynasty with Cavour and Garibaldi.
	Turin is also the capital of football with the team of Juventus in 2006 and the Winter Olympic Games in Turin will be the world capital of sport.
