Situated in the heart of vineyards and orchards, Martigny is famous for its gastronomy, honored in many excellent restaurants and inns. Under the warm Valais sun, strawberries, apricots, grapes and asparagus flourish in the region, in the midst of vineyards and orchards. Already in the past, personalities such as Rousseau, Goethe, Stendhal or Liszt have been seduced by the culinary attractions of the region. Stop to take a photo of the restored amphitheater, thermal baths, temples and Roman living quarters. Stroll through the historic district of La Bâtiaz. Visit the Pierre Gianadda Foundation: Reference museum in Switzerland and Europe. An exhibition space, built in 1978 by Léonard Gianadda in homage to his deceased brother and which has since hosted the works of the greatest: Cézanne, Picasso, Matisse, Renoir.
